ORDER
Dated Barpeta, the 3rd may, 2021

Pursuant to the Notification No. 35, dated 01-05-2021, issued by the Hon'ble Gauhati High Court, this is for information of the learned members of the Barpeta Bar that:-

1. All courts will function in virtual mode.
2. The following category of cases will be taken up by the courts:
 - i. Bail Matters,
 - ii. Remand matters,
 - iii. Recording of statement of accused persons under Section 313 Cr.P.C.
By invoking sub-section (5) of section 313 Cr.P.C.
 - iv. Injunction matters,
 - v. Cases pending for final arguments,
 - vi. Petitions seeking interim maintenance,
 - vii. Zimma petitions,
 - viii. Recording of statements under Section 164 Cr.P.C.,
 - ix. Issuance of cheque to the claimants in MAC Cases,
 - x. Rent deposit cases.
 - xi. Any other matters which is deemed to be of utmost important and urgency

(Remand matters and recording of statements under Sec 164 of Cr.P.C. shall be taken up by the concerned Magistrates, who shall ensure physical production of the accused/victims, by observing strict Covid-19 protocols).

1. For filing of fresh matters involving urgency, the e-mail I/D communicated earlier shall be used and Shri Rajiv Jaisawal (Mobile No.8133987485) and Shri Gaurab Chaudhury (Mobile No.9101749069) shall be the Nodal Persons for the establishment of the undersigned and Shri Atiqur Rahman(Mobile No.8638493650) and Shri Nikunja Vikram Medhi (Mobile No.9365757614) shall be the Nodal Persons for the

establishment of the CJM, Barpeta.

2. The concerned Advocate shall submit the soft copy either through the dedicated e-mail or submit pen-drive to the dedicated Nodal Person.

3. The Conference Hall of the undersigned shall be used for conducting cases through virtual mode for the courts of the undersigned and of the CJM establishment, Barpeta and shall be available to those Advocates who do not have the adequate facility to participate in the proceedings through remote VC.

4. Only the Advocates, or litigants (where necessary), whose cases are listed on a particular date will be allowed to enter the court premises on the date fixed.

5. The learned Barpeta Bar Association is requested to ensure that the Bar Rooms and Canteen are remain closed so as to avoid mass gathering and spread of Corona Virus.

6. The learned lawyers, litigants, members of the staff, security staff etc., shall be subjected to thermal screening before entry into the Court Complex. A register will be maintained at the entry points of the court complexes where the person entering into the Court complex shall disclose proper identify and contact numbers.

7. The above arrangement will remain in force w.e.f. 3rd May, 2021 to 16th May, 2021.
